NEW SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED THROUGH THE RICHLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION! APPLICATIONS OPEN MARCH 25, 2024.

Andreas Family FFA Promise Program Scholarship, beginning Fall 2024:

- Open to graduating seniors involved in their high school FFA program within the Richland Community College district
- Covers tuition, fees, and books
- Renewable for up to 8 semesters, summer semesters are eligible but not required
- Students must reapply each semester and enroll in at least 3 credit hours for each Fall and Spring semester to remain active
- Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA and complete the FAFSA each year
- Open to all majors, may be pursuing a degree or certificate

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment Scholarships Available, beginning Summer 2024:

- Open to Dual Credit and Dual Enrollment students that are responsible for all or part of the cost of tuition, fees, or books
- Application deadline of May 1, 2024 to be considered for summer scholarships
- Early Consideration deadline of June 15, 2024 for fall, applications may continue to be accepted if funding remains available
- Scholarships may cover tuition, fees, or books
- Students must be in good academic standing
- High School Counselor reference required (sent out through scholarship software)

General Scholarship information for graduating seniors:

- Students must apply to Richland and activate their student account before applying
- Deadline for Summer consideration is May 1, 2024
- Early consideration deadline for Fall is June 15, 2024
- Students must be registered, have submitted their FAFSA to Richland, and have submitted their transcript (7th semester accepted) before eligibility can be determined
